

OLEXIY HARAN is Professor of Comparative Politics at the National University of Kyiv Mohyla Academy (UKMA). In 1991-93, he was Dean and organizer of the Faculty of Social Sciences at the re-born Kyiv-Mohyla Academy. Since 2002, he has served as Founding Director of the UKMA School for Policy Analysis, and since 2015 as Research Director at the Democratic Initiatives Foundation, a leading Ukrainian analytical and sociological think tank. He is the co-editor of *Constructing a Political Nation: Changes in the Attitudes of Ukrainians during the War in the Donbas* (2017), *Ukraine in Europe: Questions and Answers* (2009), *Russia and Ukraine: Ten Years of Transformation* (Moscow 2003) and several other books. Also, he is a frequent commentator in Ukrainian and international media.

In winter 2013-2014, Prof. Haran was a member of the Council of 'Maidan' movement. As a political scientist he spent several weeks at the frontline nearby Mariupol, Luhansk, Avdiivka, and Donetsk airport. He is a member of Public Council under Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine and a member of Washington-based Program on New Approaches to Research and Security in Eurasia (PONARS-Eurasia).
