АНОТАЦІЯ

Метою курсу є надання студентам аналітичних інструментів для розуміння особливого характеру зовнішньої політики ЄС, який не є класичним актором у міжнародних відносинах, оскільки має більше повноважень щодо прийняття рішень, ніж міжнародна організація і менше, ніж унітарна держава. В першій частині курсу особливу увагу приділено теоретичним підходам. У другому блоці курсу акцент зроблено на внутрішніх можливостях зовнішньополітичної діяльності, зокрема розглядається інституційна структура та зовнішньополітичні компетенції. У наступній частині аналізується різноманіття зовнішньополітичних зав'язків ЄС, починаючи від торгівлі та проблем м'якої безпеки до дипломатичних та військових подій. Також розглянуто Європейську політику сусідства, Східне партнерство та відносини з Україною.
